### PÄHKINÄRINNE ALLOTMENT GARDEN

Our operation is based on working together. We have a garden work bee every spring, summer and autumn. It is a way of creating a sense of community. We come together to do necessary chores at the allotments.

Season begins in Spring by meeting old and new neighbours at a common cleaning work bee. Lending and borrowing tools and equipment, and helping other volunteers is an important value for us at the allotments. We also let plant grow to their natural measures. At the end of season, we have a Harvest festivals, which is an end of season party.

### RULES FOR PÄHKINÄRINNE ALLOTMENT GARDENERS (revised 1.3.2017)

- Produce of allotments is private property of gardeners, including equipment and tools.
- Do not walk across allotments or step on plantings, each allotment must have a passageway for transporting wheelbarrows and tools.
- Gardener is responsible for keeping the allotment, passageway and its surroundings tidy.
- Wheelbarrows and other tools that are borrowed must be returned to their place immediately after use. This includes garden furniture.
- All non-biodegradable waste (plastic, glass containers etc.) must be removed from the area
- Dogs must be fastened at the area; they are not allowed to be free
- In case you notice any defects (e.g. leak in the water hose), please contact Pehtoori
- Loud or otherwise disruptive behavior is not appropriate in the area. We respect each other's privacy
- If allotment is left unplanted during a year, the allotment is given to the next one in waiting list at the beginning of next year.
